NUMBER OF DRUG GANGS

There are over 1,000 different County Lines Drug Gangs operating across the country generating thousands of pounds in illegal profits. Innocent children, teenagers, and whole families are continuing to be threatened, exploited, abused and groomed, face to face and on-line.
Lives ruined and taken.

RECORDED DEATHS

Record levels of drug deaths are being reported.

THE PRICE BEING PAYED. . .

Young people are exposed to “risky behavior” connected to gangs.

Young people becoming homeless and abused.

VIOLENT GANGS ONLINE GROOMING

Gangs are using social media, death threats, knives, machetes and firearms daily to terrorise and kill. Thousands of youths in the UK identify as gang members.

Violent gangs continue to prey on different demographics; young females, community members, and those with special needs requirements including innocent Children as young as primary school age are now being targeted.

- Debt, enslavement, degradation
 - Squatting in squalor
 - Forced to carry out criminal activities over long periods

The consultation was announced as the prime minister was due to hold a summit on the knife crime epidemic at Downing Street with expert agencies, ministers, and community leaders.
